What's important on your beekeeping journey is that you listen, read, and observe as much information about this hobby as you can. Classes are offered throughout the spring, summer, and early fall, and most consist of small group instruction, averaging 10 to 15 students per class. We also offer private instruction as time permits. Hands-on instruction is offered and most activities take place outdoors, weather-permitting.

- Why honey bees swarm?
- What the three types/genders of bees found in a hive are?
- Why it make sense for bees to construct hexagonal comb?
- How warm the outside temperature need to be before the bees will fly?
- How and where honey bees carry pollen and nectar back to the hive?
- How many eyes a honey bee has?
- Why we wear white or light colored clothing when inspecting the hive?
- How much honey the average worker bee produces in a lifetime?
- How long a lifetime is for a summer worker bee?
